

## **STEPS TAKEN TO KEEP K.I.D.S. STAMP PARTICIPATION HIGH**

- Have the teachers talk about the program at home visits – take a stamp book along to show the parents & children.
- Continue to publicize in the school and church newsletters about the current rates of interest, types of LCEF accounts available, etc.
- Talk to grandparents at Grandparents' Day at school encouraging them to give money for birthdays, Christmas, etc. and designate it for K.I.D.S. Stamps.
- Put the loan photos on the hallway wall for students, parents, and visitors to see how the savings of the children help build schools and churches to share the love of Jesus.
- Send a letter home at the end of April letting the parents know how much money is needed to fill up their child's stamp book before the end of the school year. We use the letter form Maria Hendrickson provides.
- At the last chapel service the students who have filled a K.I.D.S. Stamp book during the school year come to the chancel area of the church and have a group picture taken as they hold up stamp books and prizes. The picture and an article are then submitted to the church newsletter for recognition.
- Send K.I.D.S. Stamp coin boxes home at the end of the school year for the children to use for saving during the summer to buy stamps in September.
